The back of the book contains 12 monthly retreat models for a 1-day retreat. [NOTE that the same invocation, psalm, hymn, and benediction is repeated each day for a week.] 4. The "Readings for Reflection" reach back to early Christian classics and include voices from contemporary spiritual writing.
